4 couple line set

"Four-a-Five" real was written for the Scottish Country Dance Society of Berlin's 45th anniversary weekend in October.

## Bars Description

- 1-4 1st couple sets and cast down to 2nd position. 2nd couple steps up.
- 5-8 1<sup>st</sup> couple right hand turn in centre.

The "four people dance a square while a fifth person dances in the centre" figure

- 9-24 1st couple dances a "cloverleaf relay": 1st lady casts around 3rd lady position for 4 bars and dances back up into centre where her partner has been dancing solo. Passing right hand he casts down and around 3<sup>rd</sup> man's position and back in from men's side while 1<sup>st</sup> lady dances solo in the centre. 1<sup>st</sup> lady repeats around 2<sup>nd</sup> man's position and then 1<sup>st</sup> man repeats around 2<sup>nd</sup> lady's position.

  Meanwhile 2s and 3s dance a "hello-goodbye square" as in J. B. Milne: 2s and 3s cross right hand for two, face each other to set right and then set left to next corner up or down the dance; repeat on side, across and then on own side again.
- 25-32  $1^{st}$  lady dances reel of 3 with the  $2^{nd}$  couple as  $1^{st}$  man dance reel with  $3^{rd}$  couple crossing back to own side at the end.

 $1^{st}$  couple ready to dance the dance again from  $2^{nd}$  position.
